- Saxophone (YAS26 M99044) in need of service, spare loaned out AS100 29170 and returned (14.8.2020)
- [Student] saxophone mouthpiece moving around (11.8.2020) AS100 29321. Loaned YAS26 M98686 on 12.8.2020 as a short-term replacement while hers is replaced. She then left the school and returned loaned instrument. Repaired instrument is still with Intune.
- Flute repair required to YFL211 851765P. Loan arranged 7.8.2020 (YFL221 D35808).
