



IMPORTANT NETBALL & NET SET GO REGISTRATION INFORMATION

< PLEASE READ TO MAKE REGO EASIER >

Happy New Year to all our new and returning members. May 2022 bring us all good health and greater certainty... not to mention more netball! Please see below, some important notes that will make 2022 registration easier for you.

WPS students in school years/grades 2 & 3 (2022) must register on the NetSetGo registration form link

**WPS students in school years/grades 4, 5, & 6 (2022) must register on the Junior Netball form link
(Use the Netball form even if you are still 9 & in Yr 4)**

- 2022 registration fee is unchanged at **\$185**. This includes all transaction fees, which are being absorbed by the club. (Your own bank may charge a separate fee.)
- All WPSNC registrations must be **paid in full**; please contact us confidentially if you require assistance with this payment.
- This is a **new registration system** called PlayHQ
- **Your early registration is much appreciated.**
- **Active Kids \$100 rebate** is claimable via Service NSW website, using your child's Medicare number. Obtain the voucher number **BEFORE you commence registration**. Your fee will be reduced to \$85.
- Enter the \$100 AKV discount at the payment screen, in the GOVERNMENT vouchers section.
- The 2022 winter comp runs from April until early September 2022 – no games in school holidays.
- All games are played at Willoughby Leisure Centre.
- All parents/guardians/carers are requested to read and acknowledge the Club's T&Cs which include a **privacy policy and codes of conduct**. The full conditions of registration can be read at <https://www.wpsandc.com.au/netball/>
- Netball players in school grades 4, 5 & 6 must be able to attend **team grading and squad training** (see dates over before you register).
- Team Managers and other volunteers are vital for the smooth running of our Club. Please use the relevant section to express your interest in helping.

Important questions you need to answer when registering:

- In 2022 - what school year is your daughter in, eg, Yr 3? It's important you enter their correct 2022 grade.
- For standard mandatory medical questions – enter **NA** if you do not have relevant answers.

NETBALL ONLY

- Players must nominate **2 preferred playing positions**.
- Year 4/U10 parents please encourage your child to choose positions **other than** GA and C, unless they are truly suited to these positions.

NSG ONLY

- Did your daughter play NSG in 2021? Y/N
- If your daughter is joining/staying in an EXISTING TEAM – name two players in the team (first name/last initial)
- If your daughter is NEW or does not have a team, please name one friend she would like to play with.

***Covid safety procedures & restrictions may impact the 2022 netball season, including spectator restrictions.
Changes will be communicated as promptly as possible.***

Jewellery

- Jewellery including earrings, watches and friendship bands cannot be worn & must be removed.
- Nails must be short & smooth.
- **DO NOT GET YOUR DAUGHTERS EARS PIERCED BEFORE OR DURING THE NETBALL SEASON AS SHE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY.** Earrings **CANNOT** be taped.

NSG Specific Information

- NSG teams must provide their own parent manager, coach* & umpire. (*Club can assist finding a student coach)
- NSG team training takes place at school on either Tuesday or Thursday mornings (7.45 – 8.45am) or Thursday afternoons (3.15 - 4.30pm*), as best suits the majority of the team members and coach.
- Girls **STARTING** to play in NSG in Yr 3, 2022 or Yr 2 individual players, will be allocated a team to play with. We try to ensure all requests to play with friends/classmates are met.
- Children starting NSG in Yr 2, who turn 7 in 2022, may play 3 years of NSG.

All **Netball** players will need to attend **grading**.

- U10s, U11s and U12s players will be individually graded & allocated to teams based on age, skill, ability & position selection. The team selection process is independent & undertaken by experienced graders. Coaches & managers from the previous season are also asked to rank their players.
- Junior netball teams play in a competition where all Clubs individually grade both their players & teams to ensure all girls are playing in the division which best reflects their capabilities.
- In registering your daughter for WPS Netball Club you agree to accept the team grading decisions of the Club. If you chose to withdraw your daughter from the Club following grading you will forfeit the registration fee.
- Please note, we play in a competition based on calendar-year age groups, not school grade groups. However, as a school Club we are aware the majority of players prefer to remain with their grade peers. Decisions regarding calendar year age-based teams can only be made when all registrations are received & grading commences.
- Yr 4 players attend U10s grading. (There's a remote chance young Yr 4 players, 9 years in 2021, may play NSG 'A'.)
- Yr 5 players attend U11s grading. (If your daughter is 'young' you may be requested to attend the 2nd U10 session.)
- Yr 6 players attend U12 grading. (If your daughter is 'young' you may be requested to attend the 3rd U11 session.)

- All teams will train as a grade squad at the start of training each week, then split into their individual teams for the 2nd half of training.
- Each year will have a Head Coach/Supervisor & individual Team Coaches.
- Netball team training is at school & will commence at 3.15pm through to 4.30pm*, however some teams or players may choose to finish at 4.15pm.
