Grounds Committee Report

Rose Garden

Since the Rose Garden was successfully 'rescued' in August 2017, we have been focussing on maintaining its development (e.g. weeding, staking, pruning, mulching etc). All the work this year has been conducted direct work by the committee members themselves (and a few of their friends). The new school handyman (Graham) has also been quite active and has helped prune, fertilise and water the Rose Garden.
