- \$175 registration fee was charged. Registration opened on January 1, 2019 and to encourage prompt registration during the holiday period 3 x \$100 Rebel gift vouchers were offered to randomly drawn players registered before 18 January. Thanks to Jenni Brown new P&C Co-president for contributing the vouchers from the P&C Rebel points.
- Active Kids has again had strong uptake.
- As at today, we have 170 players and 20 teams. There have been some tricky age group numbers to juggle.
- Thanks to parents for bringing their girls to grading sessions and assisting as needed.
- Grading went smoothly and teams are due for release later this week. Our sincere thanks to the 3 independent graders and all our xWPSNC umpires.
- Three sessions were held for each our U10s and U11s, and were invaluable. The second session was not needed for U12s as there were only 2 teams.
- U8 and U9 friendship teams are all but finalized, with registrations still trickling in. and w
- Kit distribution and training shortly will commence shortly.

- WPS Netball Club FB page is now operating as an additional communications tool. Members are encouraged to sign up.
- The WPSNC 2019 calendar circulated to members and school.
- Netball kit and ball storage has been addressed by the wonderful new GA Graham. Space has been allocated in the “dungeon” with hooks to keep the equipment off the damp floor and allow air circulation.
- Court availability at school is likely to be retained with intermittent building disruption for the 2019 season. All coaches will be briefed on the safety measures and usage rules, regarding bathrooms, sand, changing poles/posts etc.
- Booking of the court Monday to Friday before and after school from April to September has been made with DP Michelle Upston.
- NETS refresher clinic well attended. NSG session to be held in March, with bookings still being made.

The requirements for adults over 18 years and parents coaching teams other than those containing their children are currently not relevant to the club as parent coaches only coach their own children and we have no ‘non parent’ coaches over 18 years.
