CONVENORS' REPORT

- **Confirmation of Committee roles** - recruiting for Years 5/6 coordinator roles. SK to take on role of Events Coordinator. The position of Umpiring Convenor is not confirmed.
- **Clinic Updates** – 32 girls present for Monday nets clinic, 45 girls for Wednesday session. Feedback was positive from parents and players. NSG clinic – 30+ registrations
- **2020 registration and review** – As at today, we have 163 players and 18 teams. Juniors - 3 x U12 teams of 9 girls, 3 x U11 teams of 8 girls, 4 x U10 team (3 x 9 girls, 1 x 10 girls). NSG – 8 teams – 4 x U9, 1 x U9/U8/U7 combined and 3 x U8
- **Grading** – Three sessions were held for each our U10s and U11s, and were invaluable. The second session was not needed for U12s as there were only 3 teams. With thanks to everyone for their patience due to wet weather conditions.
- **Team announcements** – junior team announcements made on Friday, 21 February.
- **Coach and training allocations** – training times locked in for all teams. Most teams have volunteered coaches or been allocated high school xWPS coaches. These will be confirmed by 6 March. Training will commence as soon as kits are distributed, likely w/c 9/3.

- **Equipment and kits** – Mel and Lisa will check on kits from last year, purchase any items required and distribution will commence.
- **School court renovation** – 15 out of 18 teams want to train on the school court, mostly in the mornings. We have been advised that we have use of the court in term 1, however it will be upgraded during the school holidays and into Term 2. All going well, court will be back in use in week 2 or 3 of term 2. However, if asbestos is found, the court will not be available for most of term 2. The Netball Club expressed great concern about the timing. Further the Club contacted P&C to ensure that both 8 foot and 10 foot hoops were included in the new court goal systems to accommodate both the junior teams and the NSG teams.

Action plan –

- Mel to look into using Club Willoughby courts for NSG players as shorter hoops are already there.
- Mel to approach WGHS with help of the P7C committee for use of one of their new or existing courts for Juniors. Also to look at the use of WLC courts.
- Parents will need to look at walking buses or rosters for transporting teams to and from the courts whilst the court realignment and renovation is taking place.
- P&C advised they will help with the costs of the court hire in term 2.
- A significant communications campaign will be required to inform parents/carers, coaches, managers of the changed training conditions to ensure we meet our duty of care to our players.
- **Calendar and communications with members and school** – Deadline for school newsletter additions is every second Wednesday. Sally Roberts will update information on social media.
