REPORT FOR TERM 1 P&C MEETING

- 178 registrations for the 2015 season.
- This is the Club's biggest intake and will result in:
 - 6 teams in the under 10 age group
 - 3 teams in the under 11 age group
 - 3 teams in the under 12 age group
- The early-bird incentive was a success in encouraging people to register before the end of 2014, resulting in over 100 early registrations. It is recommended that this is continued given the tight timeframe between start of school year and NSNA registration deadline for season.
- The program for grading has been well-received, offering two sessions for all age groups and hosting it at on the school courts, rather than the Leisure Centre courts.
- Grading has been undertaken by two officials from the NSNA (one of whom grades representative players). This has ensured the best independent analysis of the Club's players.
- The graded teams will be announced via email in week 5 of term 1.
- The 2015 season starts on 27 March. ALL netball games will be held at the Leisure Centre on Friday nights (including the under 12 players, who have previously been scheduled for play on a Saturday morning). Net Set Go games will continue to be held at the Legions Club courts.
- Linda Shaw has volunteered to act as the Club's Umpires Convenor, filling the vacancy left with the resignation of Kim Nielson. This was supported by the members of the Committee at a meeting on 17 February 2015.
- Gala day (normally held early in term 1) has been removed from the 2015 calendar due to time restrictions and the double session of

grading.

- The Anne Sargeant Clinics have also been removed from the 2015 calendar due to the lack of revenue generated from this very time-consuming process and a lack of volunteer to co-ordinate. The NSNA offers Anne Sargeant and Liz Ellis clinics and the Club will communicate these opportunities to parents for independent booking.
- Rosina Blake has again purchased Swifts tickets on behalf of the Club. Tickets for the game to be held on 3 May will be made available for sale, with a small profit for the Club. Ticket price to be determined but will be in line with the 2014 pricing.
- The NSNA will undertake grading of the under 10 teams on Friday, 13 March.
- School Principal, Bill Bird, has proposed organising a school excursion for netball players to view the Netball World Club, being held in Sydney from 7-16 August 2015. The Club supports this and is happy to assist with communications but understands this will be a school-managed excursion.
- Current financial position is attached.
