



## **P&C FUNDS 2019**

Through the school year WPS uses the funds made available by the P&C Association to supplement the programs and resources required to provide the best educational opportunities for students.

In 2019 P&C funds were used in the following programs.

### **School Learning Support Officers (SLSO) - \$52,000**

A team of SLSOs are employed to support the learning of students across the school from Year 1 to 4, running Minilit and Spelling Mastery programs with students requiring support with their learning. SLSOs also work in class with targeted students requiring specific adjustments to their learning program. They assist with the transition of our Kindergarten students in their first year at school, working in classrooms and playgrounds alongside teachers.

### **Learning Support and English resources - \$11,934**

Each year funds are allocated within the school budget (\$25,000) to upgrade and replace existing resources that support teaching programs across the school. This year funds were used to purchase new readers.

### **Technology Resources - \$11,000**

Through the use of P&C and school funds, we were able to replace 3 data projectors, also repair and maintain iPad fleet.
